Need For Preservation of Vedic Knowledge

India owes its magnificent spiritual heritage to the Vedas. They are the storehouse of Indian wisdom and a great source of inspiration to mankind for millions of years. The concepts of "Viswamedam" (Global Family) and "Vasudhaiva kutumbakam" (whole world as one family) have emanated from the Vedas and are the soul of our Vedic heritage.

However the four Vedas which were having 1131 branches about 5000 years ago, were reduced to 12 branches by 1947 and further reduced to 7 branches by 1991.

Contributions of Shri Veda Bharathi

In view of the alarming situation, Shri Veda Bharathi (SVB) was conceived in 1992 as a historical necessity. SVB immediately commenced the work of preserving the Vedic knowledge from texts and voice of pandits in to Audio & Multimedia devices (CDs/DVDs/Pen Drives etc). Further SVB has been carrying out -

- Research for modern sciences in Vedas and other texts of Sanskrit (Predictability of Earth quakes using Indian Astronomy etc.),
- Publication of papers and books on Vedic sciences,
- Training & teaching programmes (on Vedic Maths, Prasthanatrayam etc.,) through TV Channels and online (ZOOM),
- Workshops & Seminars for the Scientists & Professionals on various aspects of Vedic knowledge, etc.

SVB has so far brought out about 170 books & papers, 80 Vedic DVDs and about 5000 studio hours of recording of Vedic Chantings.

Need For Rathayatra :

Many people in society, including the youth of the present generation, are unaware of **Sanatana Dharma** in general and **Sri Adi Sankaracharya** in particular, who dedicated his life for fastering unity among the apparently divergent segments of Hindu Society through "Panchayatana" model of worship. The responsibility to educate our youth on these lines lies entirely with us. If our culture is to endure, the glory of **Sri Adi Sankaracharya** must be propagated far and wide.

Performance of special worships and continuous propagation of **Sanatana Dharma**



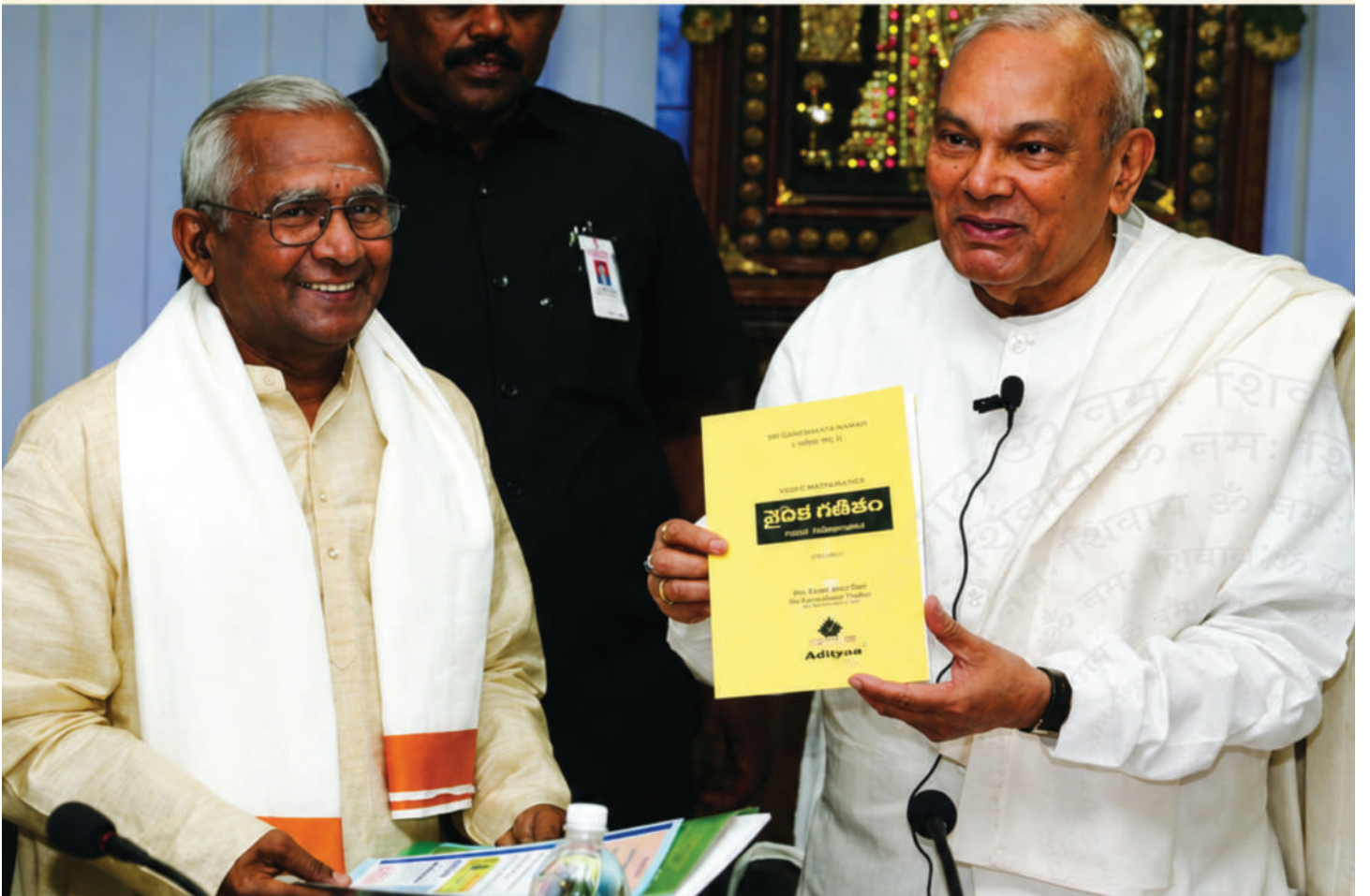

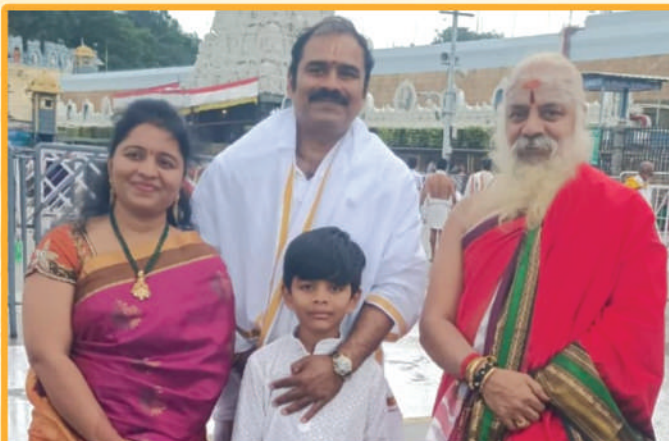
